Re: Bonita Springs City Council Report of Wednesday, January 4, 2006

Item 6A – Council heard a presentation from Bob Stewart, Vice President of the National Association of Railroad Passengers, on passenger rail service in the United States. He stated for every dollar invested in passenger rail the average return to the community is \$10. He also stated the US is far behind Europe in rail transit and it was the most efficient and effective use of transportation dollars in the 21st Century. He recommended council support Council Member Grant in his quest to bring rail to Southwest Florida.

Item 7 – Consent Agenda

• The consent agenda was approved with the exception of Item H, the agreement with Lee County Sheriff's office for law enforcement services. This item will be brought back at the next meeting.
